Namaste!

We are writing to inform you about the upcoming PARAKH Rashtriya Sarvekshan 2024, which has been entrusted to the National Assessment Centre PARAKH, NCERT, by the Ministry of Education, Government of India. Formerly, the National Achievement Survey, PARAKH Rashtriya Sarvekshan is a national-level large-scale assessment conducted every three years. It provides valuable insights into educational achievements and advancements across the country. The assessment for this year is planned for November 2024, with a tentative date set for 19th November.

The primary objective of PARAKH Rashtriya Sarvekshan 2024 is to develop a new high-quality global assessment aligned with the National Curriculum Framework for School Education 2023 (NCF-SE 2023). This national survey will assess students at grades 3, 6, and 9, in line with the objectives outlined in the National Education Policy 2020.

Specifically, PARAKH Rashtriya Sarvekshan 2024 aims to assess competencies at the end of the foundational, preparatory, and middle stages in the following subjects:

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Annexure B

Concept Note: For Parakh Rastriya Sarvekshan (erstwhile National Achievement Survey) 2024

The Ministry of Education, Government of India, has notified the Parakh Rastriya Sarvekshan, a standardised assessment for grades 3, 6, and 9, which will be conducted with a sample set of schools across Himachal Pradesh on 19 November 2024. This survey is a continuation of the National Achievement Survey conducted in 2021. It is important to note that the assessed grades have changed to grades 3, 6, and 9, from the earlier grades 3, 5, 8, and 10. Competencies which are part of the curricular goals defined under National Curriculum Framework for School Education 2023 (NCF-SE) will be assessed as part of the same. The assessment will be done on OMR sheets and will assess the following subjects –

As part of the preparations, and as per the instructions of the Honorable Education Minister of Himachal Pradesh, the following steps are to be taken to improve results in mission mode:

- 1. 45-Minute Zero Hour-** Schools are to implement a 45-minute zero hour every day for practice for grades 3, 6, and 9 on the mentioned subjects. The practice is to be focused on defined competencies. 2 competencies per subject will be practiced in one week, and the calendar for the same will be shared with schools.
- 2. Question Bank-** Questions for practice can be picked up from an online question bank, the link of which will be shared with the teachers by concerned block and cluster officials. Teachers can also frame their own questions for the practice. Sample plans for remediation and practice lesson plans will also be provided.
- 3. Homework Practice on Abhyas Himachal bot -** At the end of the week, teachers should give students homework to practice questions on Abhyas Himachal, which will also be linked to the competencies specified for the week. On Monday, teachers should discuss questions of Abhyas Himachal on the blackboard and check student notebooks.

The efforts will be closely monitored by the department through school visits. Three sample mock tests will also be conducted in the beginning of September, beginning of October and end of October. Schools for this will be selected randomly, and teachers are expected to ensure that students are ready. The same competencies which are covered in that particular month will be assessed.

All schools are required to immediately follow these instructions and ensure regular practice of students. Deputy Directors and Block Education Officers are to ensure adherence to the same.


