Subject: Regarding findings of PARAKH Practice Assessment (Mock - 2) and schedule for PARAKH Practice Assessment (Mock - 3)




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



Cumulative Comparative Insights

- Performance trends have seen growth in all subjects across grades except for EVS grade 3 and Hindi grade 9
- Participation of students went up from 85% to 96% across state.
- No OCR deficit has been reported.
- Highest improvement was shown by Bilaspur and Lahaul and Spiti in overall performance.
- For Mock - 2, Math in grade 6 and 9 came out to be the weakest.
