## Advisor on the Online Sale of Tobacco Products and E-Cigarettes.

Whereas, this advisory is issued in continuation of advisory issued on 28.08.2018 by the Mustor of Health and Family Welfare to all States and UTs to ensure that any Electronic Nectine Delivery Systems (ENDS) including e-Cigarettes, Heat-Not-Burn devices, Vape, e-Sheesha, e-Nicotine Flavoured Hookah, and the like devices that enable nicotine delivery are not sold (including online sale), manufactured, distributed, traded, imported and advertised in the flurisdictions, except for the purpose and in the manner and to the extent, as may be approved under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Rules made thereunder.

- And whereas, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare previously issued instructions to all the States and UTs for the rigorous enforcement of COTPA, 2003 and PECA, 2019 vide D.D. letters from Secretary, Health (July 2020-July 2023), Secretary, Health (February 2024-September 2024), Director General of Health Services and Additional Secretary, Ministry of neath and Family Welfare.
- And whereas, the Government of India has enacted the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act (COTPA), 2003 with emphasis on protecting the masses, escecially children and young people from tobacco addiction and alming to improve public health in general as enshrined in Article 47 of the Constitution of India. As per sections 5, 6 and 7 of COTPA, 2003, no person shall promote the use or consumption of cigarettes or any other tobacco product; no person shall sell or offer for sale or permit sale of cigarettes or any other tobacco products to any person who is under eighteen years of age and within 100 yards of any educational institution; and no person shall carry on trade or commerce in agarettes or any other tobacco products unless every package of cigarettes or any other tobacco products unless every package of cigarettes or any other tobacco products unless every package of cigarettes or any other tobacco products unless every package of cigarettes or any other tobacco products unless every package of cigarettes or any other tobacco products sold, supplied or distributed has the specified health warning.
- And whereas, the section 77 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children)

  Act. 2015, whoever gives, or causes to be given, to any child under 18 years of age tobacco
  products, shall be punished with rigorous imprisonment.

Production, Manufacture, Import, Export, Transport, Sale, Distribution, Storage Sarettes (Production, Manufacture, Import, Export, Transport, Sale, Distribution, Storage Saled Advertisement) Act, 2019 in the interest of public health and to protect the people from thams of nicotine. Section 4 of PECA, 2019 inter alia prohibits production, manufacturing, import, export, transport, sale, distribution, storage and advertisement of electronic cigarettes.

6. And whereas, in view of the above statutory provisions, it has to be ensured that it charge and electronic cigarette industries do not sell their products illicitly through ecommerce sites/apps and in the close vicinity of educational institutions; thereby increasing the accessibility of these products to youth.

CUMI -

As such in accordance with the previously issued advisories, all States and Union as are advised, in large public health interest to take appropriate action against the saler of the tobacco products and e-cigarettes. This action should be taken under 5 read with Section 22, Section 6 read with Section 24, and Section 7 read with Section 7 of the COTPA 2003, Section 77 of the Juvenile Justice Act 2015, and Section 4 registernet-based platforms.
