





Sign up process for school user's on SHVR web?


To begin the registration or login process on the SHVR Web Portal, school users should:

- Locate the “**Login/Sign-Up**” button positioned at the **top-right corner** of the page, within the official **Menu Bar section**.
- Click this button to be redirected to the **secure login screen**. The Login/Sign-up screen is shown in Figure- 2 below.



Step 1: Enter UDISE+ Code and Captcha

Step 2 & 3: Enter Mobile Number and Verify with OTP



- ▶ **Step 4:** The system will **automatically fetch basic school details** (e.g., school name, district, state) from the UDISE+ portal. The users must **review the details and provide consent** to save the information into the SHVR system.




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After sign-up, each school user must fill out the **School Profile Form**—a one-time mandatory step to ensure accurate and updated data, aligned with the **UDISE+ database**.


How to Submit Survey?

- Once logged in, school users are directed to the **School Dashboard**—the central hub for accessing all SHVR features.
- The dashboard displays **six clickable cue cards**, each representing a survey category (e.g., Water, Sanitation, Handwashing).
- These cards become **active only after the full school profile is completed and submitted**




Click on the survey category and start filling the survey form

- ▶ After completing the survey, schools must upload photos as **mandatory supporting evidence** for each of the six survey categories. These images help **validate responses** and enhance **transparency** during evaluation.

Assessment Framework Overview

Assessment Methodology:

- Self-assessment by schools through mobile/web platform
- Upload of evidence: geo-tagged photos, documents, videos
- Validation by district-level evaluators using standardised tools



Rating System:

- 5-star rating based on cumulative scores
- Separate recognitions at District, State/UT, and National levels



Weightage and Scoring:

- Varies per category based on priority and impact
- Combines infrastructure and behaviour-based indicators

Rating at District Level

- ▶ Appointment of a Nodal officer.
- ▶ Online (web/mobile) applications received before cut off date will be screened at district level, headed by **district collector** (his/her nominee) and other members.
- ▶ **School will be eligible for certificate of merit with at least 51% score**
- ▶ Two categories: **Category I:** Grades 1 to 8
Category II: Grades 9 to 12.
- ▶ **Four categories** for star rating: Rural- category-I, Rural- category-II, Urban- Category-I, Urban- Category-II
- ▶ **Rural:** 3 schools from category I and 3 from category II with rating not below 3 Star (**Total 6 schools**)
- ▶ **Urban:** 1 from category I and Category II having score not below 3 star (**Total 2 schools**)
- ▶ District level committee for physical verification of schools through eligible evaluators decided by committee.
- ▶ Selected schools with **highest overall score (Total 8)** will be given certificate of merit.
- ▶ Each of selected schools with highest overall score (total 8) will be nominated for state level recognition.
