
**Subject: Information required for Need Assessment on Mentorship for students in

The vision of Department of Social Justice and Empowerment (DoSJE) is to build an inclusive society where members of target groups can lead productive safe and dignified lives with adequate support for their growth and development. The aim is to support and empower its target group through programs of educational, economic and social development, and rehabilitation wherever necessary. The mandate of DoSJE is empowerment of the socially, educationally and economically marginalized section of society.

2. The Department of Social Justice and Empowerment (DoSJE) is implementing various scholarship schemes for SCs viz Pre & Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme, Top Class scholarship, SHREYAS etc. The support of the state/UTs government is critical for successful implementation of the schemes.
