Subject: Organization of various activities under Swasth Nari Sashakt Parivar Campaign w. e. f. 17th September, 2025 – 2nd October 2025.

Sir/Madam,

A state-wide campaign, "Swasth Nari, Sashakt Parivar Abhiyaan", is scheduled from 17th September - 2nd October, 2025. This initiative aims to improve women's health and hygiene, enhance coverage of antenatal care and immunization services and screen women for non-communicable diseases like hypertension, diabetes and cancer. The 15 day campaign should be implemented around four key strategies: intensification of services at Ayushman Arogya Mandirs, specialist health camps, blood donation camps, and observance of PMSMA days to ensure maximum outreach and coverage of women and children. Details as per Annex 1.

Sub: Regarding Routine Immunization activity at Schools
Sir/Madam,

With reference to the DO letter no. nil dated 15/09/2025 issued by Worthy Deputy Commissioner Kangra at Dharamshala (copy enclosed) regarding organization of various activities under Swasth Nari Sashakt Parivar Campaign (SNSPA) w.e.f 17th Sep, 2025 to 2nd October 2025.

In this regard, it is inform to your goodself that under the Universal Immunization programme (UIP) of GOI the vaccination of 5 years, 10 years & 16 years children is to be conducted at all the Govt. & Private Schools under school health vaccination programme. Futher keeping in view of ongoing Swasth Nari Sashakt Parivar Campaign w.e.f 17th Sep, 2025 to 2nd October 2025 and the letter no. NHMHP-UIP0TRG/1/2019-E-11248-3608 dated 12/9/2025 received from Mission Director NHM Shimla, the special School vaccination drive at schools is to be carried out w.e.f 24th Sep to 30th Sep 2025 to cover class 1,5 and 10 students for DPT-2 booster, Td-10, Td-16 doses (copy enclosed).

In this context information has been received from Block Medical Officers that some of the big Private schools/institutions are denying for the vaccination at schools leading to interruption of the ongoing SNSPA Abhiyan & Routine Immunization Programme objectives. You are requested to disseminate necessary directions to all the Govt./Private schools to cooperate with vaccination teams of health departments for effective implemenation of the ongoing campaign and to prevent vaccine preventable diseases among school going children.

Subject:- Regarding Immunisation Drive on Swasth Nari, Sashakt Parivar Abhiyaan from 17th September to 02nd October 2025.

Sir,

This is with reference to Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & family Welfare, D.O. No. Z.28015/61/2025-NHM-I dated 05th September 2025 on the subject cited above.

As you aware that the special Immunization Campaign during 17th September-30th September in which all data is to be entered in UWIN including school vaccination coverage. For this, estimation of children in specified areas and Number of doses required are to be calculated and shared with State by 14th September positively.

The special Immunization drive will be conducted from 17th -23rd September in Disaster affected area, all High-Risk areas and Vacant sub centres. Following this, a school vaccination drive will be undertaken from 24th -30th September to ensure coverage of school going children with DPT-2 booster, TD-10, TD -16.

1. Especially focusing in Disaster affected areas, High Risk areas, Vacant Sub centres.
2. School vaccination drive to cover class 1,5 and 10 students for DPT-2 booster, TD-10, TD -16 doses. Schools with target (estimated number of children in class 1,5,10).

For this, thorough micro planning is required for which the formats are attached below:

Annexure - 1

A comprehensive screening for Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) including anaemia, hypertension, blood pressure, sugar for diabetes, oral cancer and breast cancer will be conducted at all institutions. These institutions will be registered in the institution registration module shared by the Government of India. All clients availing services during this period will be registered in the SNSP application at the health facility. Daily monitoring of the same will be done by the State/District team under the chairpersonship of the worthy Secretary (Health) to the GoHP.

Specialist Health Camps

- Specialist health camps will be conducted in all Adarsh SwasthyaSansthan of the district every day for 15 days. A target of 100 female clients per day has been set for each facility during the campaign period. Hence it is expected that at least 1500 females will be screened in each Adarsh SwasthyaSansthan during the campaign.
- The District Nodal Officer shall ensure the uploading of all the details of all these camps along with dates should be entered in the Camp Registration Module by 13th September, 2025.
- The local representatives and other dignitaries may be invited in these camps.
- The health services to be provided during the campaign attached as Annexure — '1'.
- All clients approaching these centres every day will be registered in the SNSP application. In case of challenges in online entry of the client, the details can be entered in the register and a picture of Aadhar Card of the client should be kept so that the same can be uploaded on offline mode.
- The daily progress of the camp on various health indicators should be reported on the concerned portals i.e. RCH/UWIN/NCD and AAM portal as per the indicators prescribed for this campaign.
- The required specialists should be mobilized through Medical Colleges, DH, CH, CHC. The BMOs should also encourage participation of private hospitals, FOGSI and IMA.

Pledges:

- Organize health pledges- Organize mass pledge session led by SHGs for 10% oil & sugar reduction
- Organize a visible pledge-taking by all existing Nikshay Mitras present (TB Mukta Bharat)

PHC Screening

- Under the intensification of services at PHC, priority should be given to screening of women for NCDs, including diabetes, hypertension, anaemia (Hb testing), ANC, immunization, TB screening, oral cancer and breast cancer. In addition, ASHA, AWW, Anganwadi helpers, Female Health Workers, Female Health Supervisors, CHOs, female school teachers & female staff, PRI women members and female ward members of urban bodies should undergo screening at the nearest PHC.
- Each PHC will have a target of 100 female clients screenings per day for 15 days for all the Blocks. Screening number will cumulative of screening done at PHC and associated Health Sub-Centre and Health Welness Centre.
- All clients approaching these centres every day will be registered in the SNSP application. In case of challenges in online entry of the client, the details can be

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entered in the register and a picture of Aadhar Card of the client should be kept so that the same can be uploaded on offline mode.

• The daily progress of the camp on various health indicators should be reported on the concerned portals i.e. RCH/UWIN/NCD and AAM portal as per the indicators prescribed for this campaign.

Blood Donation Camp

Blood donation camps will be organized by Blood Banks across the state. The following activities are expected in the camp:

- All the Blood banks and registered NGOs should be involved in the campaign to conduct donor registration (Registration of all participants) and medical screening.
- Collect blood safely under sterile conditions as per NACO/MoHFW guidelines.
- May involve People's Representatives in inaugurating the camp, encouraging donors, and distributing certificates of appreciation.
- Transfer collected units to the blood bank and update data on e-RaktKosh.
- Pledge on MyGov portal
- Publicly acknowledge donors, volunteers, partners, and People's Representatives through local media and social media.
- Submit report with data and photographs to the State Monitoring team

Diagnostic Testing

• Krsnaa Diagnostic and all Government labs will conduct HB and Blood Sugar testing for approximately 7 lakh population of women and children within 15 days. It should be ensured that all these clients are registered in the SNSP application. The daily reporting should be ensured to the State Monitoring Team.

• All clients approaching these centres every day will be registered in the SNSP application. In case of challenges in online entry of the client, the details can be entered in the register and a picture of Aadhar Card of the client should be kept so that the same can be uploaded on offline mode.

• The facility In-charge shall ensure optimum use of indoor labs during the campaign.

Medical College Targets

• Medical colleges will cover a target of 10,000 clients in 15 days for providing services on the lines of Specialist Camps. The health services to be provided during the campaign are attached as Annexure - '1'.

• All clients approaching these centres every day will be registered in the SNSP application. In case of challenges in online entry of the client, the details can be entered in the register and a picture of Aadhar Card of the client should be kept so that the same can be uploaded on offline mode.

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- The daily progress of the camp on various health indicators should be reported on the concerned portals i.e RCH/ UWIN/ NCDand AAM portal as per the indicators prescribed for this campaign.
- They should coordinate with the CMOs and utilized their existing staff for conduction of these activities.

Screening through RBSK teams

- The RBSK teams should conduct Hb testing for all girls in Government Senior Secondary Schools, with a minimum target of one school per day.
- To strengthen capacity, each team should be provided with an additional Hb meter (in addition to the existing one), enabling two testing points per school.
- All clients approaching these centres every day will be registered in the SNSP application. In case of challenges in online entry of the client, the details can be entered in the register and a picture of Aadhar Card of the client should be kept so that the same can be uploaded on offline mode.

Saturation of Immunization services

- A special immunization drive should be undertaken focusing on left-out and drop-out children under 5 years, especially in urban, pen-urban, high risk areas and disaster affected area. Efforts should target zero-dose children under 1 year (to receive Penta-1) and unvaccinated children for MR-1 and MR-2.

Screening on PMSMA days

- PMSMA would be celebrated on 19th September and 1st October, 2025 in addition to 27th September during the campaign for ANC services. It should be ensure that HIV and Syphilis testing of all the pregnant women is done during this period.
- The reporting should be done on PMSMA portal.
- All clients approaching these centres every day will be registered in the SNSP application. In case of challenges in online entry of the client, the details can be entered in the register and a picture of Aadhar Card of the client should be kept so that the same can be uploaded on offline mode.
- There shall be a daily monitoring and analysis of all the dashboards given by Gol. Centres not achieving targets will be shortlisted by 1:00pm the next day and the concerned by the Worthy Secretary Health on daily basis.
- The daily information should be, ensured to be uploaded on the same day.
