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Guidelines for Making "The School Complex System" Operational to Improve the Learning Outcomes; to Strengthen School Administration and to Align the Schooling System with the Objectives Outlined in National Education Policy (NEP 2020) in the State of Himachal Pradesh

**I. Introduction**

- 1.1. The State Government has taken several steps aimed at improving the quality of education in Government Schools. Positive outcomes of these steps are already being noticed. The ranking of the State has improved significantly in the National Achievement Survey (NAS) conducted by the Government of India. In the year 2021, Himachal was ranked 18th in the national rankings, and in 2024 the State was ranked number 3 (Class 2), number 5 (Class 6), and number 4 (Class 9). The ASER report released in 2025 has also noted that students in Government Schools in Himachal are the best in the country in reading ability. The State Government has introduced various reforms. The Department is also aligning its education system with the National Education Policy, 2020, keeping in view the unique needs and requirements of the State of Himachal Pradesh.
- 1.2. However, the challenge of the State is small schools, which run at a sub-optimal level and act as a barrier for students because they do not get a proper learning environment. Research has established that students and teachers perform better in large-sized schools.
- 1.3. In Para 7 of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, under the heading "*Efficient Resourcing and Effective Governance through School Complexes Clusters*", the NEP notes as under:

*7.1. While the establishment of primary schools in every habitation across the country-driven by the SarvaShikshaAbhiyan (SSA), now subsumed under the SamagraShiksha Scheme and other important efforts across the States - has helped to ensure near-universal access to primary schools, it has also led to the development of numerous very small schools. According to U-DISE 2016-17 data, nearly 28% of India's public primary schools and 14.8% of India's upper primary schools have less than 30 students. The average number of students per grade in the elementary schooling system (primary and upper*

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primary, i.e., Grades 1–8) is about 14, with a notable proportion having below 6; during the year 2016–17, there were 1,08,017 single-teacher schools, the majority of them (85,743) being primary schools serving Grades 1–5.

7.2. These small school sizes have rendered it economically suboptimal and operationally Complex to run good schools, in terms of deployment of teachers as well as the provision of critical physical resources. Teachers often teach multiple grades at a time, and teach multiple subjects, including subjects in which they may have no prior background. Key areas such as music, arts, and sports are too often simply not taught, and physical resources, such as lab and sports equipment and library books, are simply not available across schools.

7.3. The isolation of small schools also has a negative effect on education and the teaching-learning process. Teachers function best in communities and teams, and so do students. Small schools also present a systemic challenge for governance and management. The geographical dispersion, challenging access conditions, and the very large numbers of schools make it difficult to reach all schools equally. Administrative structures have not been aligned with the increases in the number of school or with the unified structure of the SamagraShiksha Scheme.

1.4. It is also important to note that while the NEP is based on the UDISE data of 2016-17, the situation has not improved after that as far as the problem of small schools is concerned. It was during Covid-19 period that the enrolment increased marginally in Government Schools but after the things normalized the enrolment in State Government Schools saw a decline again and the dip is continuing. Therefore, there is a need to focus on the entire schooling continuum, and to change the structure and strategies to realize better learning outcomes.

1.5. The NEP strongly advocates consolidation of schools by organizing schools in a School Complex, where one Senior Secondary School functions as the Leader/Nodal School for all the lower-grade schools (Primary, Middle, and High) located within the catchment area of the Senior Secondary School. Presently, the Principal of the Senior Secondary School discharges several administrative functions in respect of the High and Middle

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Schools attached to it, but the arrangement has several gaps and inconsistencies, which will be addressed through these Guidelines.

1.6. The School Complex will lead to better Learning Outcomes: Seamless Transition for the Students: Greater Resource Efficiency and Effective Functioning: Better Coordination, Effective School Leadership, besides other advantages in day-to-day functioning and management. The isolated existence of small schools (especially at Primary and Stand-Alone Middle Schools) affects student outcomes adversely and does not have a positive impact on the teaching-learning process. Students learn better in larger schools with high enrolment, and teachers function best in larger teams and communities. There is a large body of literature and research establishing that bigger, consolidated, and Complex schools improve the entire education system, especially the Learning Outcomes of the students.

1.7. One major decision that has established the foundation for the integration and consolidation of the school system is the restructuring of the Directorates of Education. Elementary and Higher Sections of the school have been merged into a single administrative unit, i.e., the Directorate of School Education. However, the administrative structure at the field level is yet to be aligned with the new administrative and governance structure. The reform of integrating separate school directorates into a single Directorate of School Education will have far-reaching positive consequences.

1.8. These Guidelines seek to streamline the administration and management of schools at the Complex level. The cluster system of school administration notified by the Department earlier shall be a subset of these Guidelines.

## 2. Need for a School Complex

2.1. School Size is an important factor in quality of education, as effective school transaction happens in bigger schools where teaching, curricular, and co-curricular activities are organized better. Average school size in Himachal, when compared with the All-India average and with the USA and China, puts things in perspective. Education systems are moving towards teaching 21st-century skills and lifelong learning models. Key skills identified as 21st-century skills (critical thinking, creativity, communication, collaboration) are best learned in larger groups, diverse teams, and through blended learning. For this to happen, we need larger, vibrant schools with high enrolment and

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adequate teaching staff. Small schools act as a barrier to optimizing the available resources. The school size in Himachal, in comparison with the All-India average and countries like the USA and China, is given in the table below.

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2.2. It is clear that the State has a large number of small schools. At the primary level, 87% of schools have fewer than 40 students. In standalone middle schools, only 7% of schools have more than 40 students. In the Senior Secondary Schools (Classes 6 to 12), 97% of schools have more than 40 students. If we can make as many as possible of our schools into one composite school from Pre-primary to Class 12, the interests of the students will be served. The dropout rate at the higher level will reduce considerably, the

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transition rate will improve, and the State will be able to achieve a 100% Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER).

- 2.3. The Pupil Teacher Ratio (PTR) and the Average School Size Category wise also highlights the situation in which we find ourselves as a State. The PTR and School Size is as follows: Primary (PTR 12, School Size 24); Upper Primary (PTR 7, School Size 21); High School (PTR 8, School Size 60); Senior Secondary School (PTR 11, School Size 187). Though we have one of the best PTR in the country, yet we have a large number of single teacher schools and/or under staffed schools. One of the reason for this is a large number of small schools at higher level. Once this imbalance is corrected, then the school system will get better aligned with the outcomes for the students.
  - 2.4. Therefore, these Guidelines are being issued to establish and run a School Complex. A School Complex shall be a group of Government Schools in an area consisting of a Government Senior Secondary School as the centre of the Complex and shall include all nearby Government High School(s), Government Middle School(s), and Government Primary School(s). Therefore, all the Government Senior Secondary Schools in the State shall function as the Nodal/Leader School for the School Complex.
  - 2.5. The revised composition of each School Complex in the State is specified in Annexures A to L appended to these Guidelines. However, the Director of School Education shall be competent to alter this composition as per geographic or administrative convenience after getting a feasibility report from the concerned Deputy Director.
  - 2.6. The Principal of the Government Senior Secondary School shall be the Administrative Head of the Complex for the purpose of day-to-day administration and implementation of all the policies, programmes, schemes, and campaigns in the Education Department. All teachers, including the heads of the subordinate schools (i.e., Headmasters; in-charge of Middle Schools; CHTs) located within the Complex, shall work under the overall administrative control of the Principal of the GSSS.
3. **Roles and Responsibilities of the Principal:** In the School Complex system of administration, the Principal shall undertake additional responsibilities in addition to his duties related to the Complex head school, as follows:
- 3.1. To visit each and every school of his complex at least once in two months and to spend entire day in the school to assess the learning levels of the students; teaching learning

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- practices and to oversee various works related to school concerned. He shall submit the report of such visits to the Deputy Director on monthly basis. The Director School Education shall devise a system to get these reports in online mode through VidyaSamiksha Kendra (VSK) for which a common format shall be devised.
- 3.2. To ensure quality education in all schools within the Complex. He shall be responsible for improvements in the learning levels of students of all classes.
  - 3.3. To ensure that no school within the Complex remains without a teacher and no class in a school remains without a teacher during academic hours. For this purpose, he may depute any teacher from one school to any other school within the Complex, irrespective of his designation, as per requirement, for a day or for a number of days. For example, any JBT teacher may be deputed to attend a class of a higher section and vice versa.
  - 3.4. To ensure convergence and sharing of resources as per the Guidelines issued by the Government vide letter dated 13.02.2024.
  - 3.5. **APARs:** The Principal shall be the Reporting Officer for the Annual Performance Appraisal Report (APAR) in respect of the teachers, including Headmasters, Central Head Teachers (CHTs), Head Teachers (HTs), and Junior Basic Teachers (JBTs), posted in all schools of the Complex, except the teachers posted in the High Schools of the Complex, in respect of whom the Headmaster shall continue to be the Reporting Officer. The Principal shall be the Reviewing Officer for all such teachers for whom the Headmaster is the Reporting Officer. The APARs of JBT, HT, and CHT shall be sent to the concerned Deputy Director of Education through the BEEO, who shall add his remarks on the APAR before forwarding it to the Deputy Director concerned. The Deputy Director will be the Reviewing and the Accepting Authority in the case of JBT/HT and CHT.
  - 3.6. **Leave:** The Principal shall be the leave sanctioning authority (all types of leave other than Casual Leave)-in respect of all teachers posted in the schools of the Complex (including JBT, HT, CHT, Headmaster, and the teachers posted in Government Middle and High Schools).

In case of Casual Leave, the Centre Head Teacher (CHT) shall be the authority to sanction the leave in respect of all the JBTs/HTs posted within the Centre, and the Head

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Master shall be the authority to sanction such leave in respect of teachers posted in High Schools. However, the Centre Head Teacher (CHT) or the Head Master, as the case may be, shall, inform the Principal about such sanction so that alternate teaching arrangements are made in time. The CHT shall also submit the proposal to depute teachers in case of temporary absence due to Casual Leave and other kinds of leave to the Principal for approval so that studies do not suffer.

In the case of leave (other than Casual Leave) in respect of the JBTs/HTs, the CHT shall forward the leave application to the Principal for sanction with his recommendations. The Principal shall forward a copy of the sanction of leave to the Block Elementary Education Officer for information.

The Principal shall be the leave sanctioning authority for all types of leave (including Casual Leave) in respect of the CHTs posted in the School Complex. A copy of the sanction of leave shall be forwarded to the Block Elementary Education Officer for information.

- 3.7. **School Adoption/Vidyanjali:** To promote school adoptions and community engagements as per the Guidelines issued by the Government from time to time for improving the quality of education in all Government schools within the Complex.
- 3.8. **Basic Amenities in the School:** To oversee the civil works and to ensure the availability of basic amenities in all schools of the Complex, such as water and electricity supply, internet connectivity, sanitation, and basic infrastructure. He will endeavor to pool resources and funds to provide all such amenities in the schools.
- 3.9. To ensure regular updating of data on UDISE+, PMIS, and other online portals of the Government.
- 3.10. To ensure proper implementation of all provisions of the Right to Education Act and other schemes and programmes being implemented in the schools of the State, such as PM-Poshan, free textbook distribution, school uniform subsidy, and scholarship schemes, etc.

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- 3.11. To coordinate with DIETs/BRCCs for effective implementation of quality education interventions being implemented by the Government through the State Project Director under the SSA/STARS Project and/or any other scheme and programme.
- 3.12. To conduct and coordinate co-curricular activities like quizzes, debates, declamations, cultural programs, yoga sessions, etc., involving all schools at the Complex level, in accordance with the instructions of the Government issued from time to time.
- 3.13. To comply with the instructions issued from time to time by any of the Deputy Directors posted at the District level.
- 4. **Roles and Responsibilities of the Block Elementary Education Officer:** The BEEO shall perform the following duties with respect to the School Complex system.
  - 4.1. He shall continue to act as the Drawing and Disbursing Officer for operating various heads of accounts in respect of primary schools.
  - 4.2. He shall continue to maintain the service books and service records of all teaching and non-teaching staff deployed in the primary schools.
  - 4.3. He will be responsible for sending all the APARs of JBTs, HTs, and CITs to the concerned Deputy Director with his remarks in the APARs, after collecting the same from all Complexes falling under his jurisdiction.
  - 4.4. He will conduct school visits/learning rounds/inspections of all primary as well as middle schools of the block.
  - 4.5. He will coordinate all the activities of primary and middle schools at the block level.
- 5. **Role and Responsibility of the Central Head Teacher**
  - 5.1. The Central Head Teachers shall continue to undertake roles and responsibilities as defined vide Government letter dated 03.08.2000, with modifications as mentioned in succeeding clauses.
  - 5.2. He shall work under the direct administrative control of the Principal and will report to him. As such, all administrative matters shall be reported to the Principal by him, whereas financial matters, such as communications with respect to salary, wages, honorarium, etc., or any other related matter, as may be asked for, shall be reported to the BEEO (DDO).

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5.3. He will forward all the leave applications for sanction and proposals of temporary deputations during the leave period of any teacher, or otherwise, to the Principal for sanction/approval.

**6. Drawing and Disbursing Powers**

6.1. The BEEO shall continue to exercise the drawing and disbursing powers in respect of all heads of accounts which they are currently operating.

6.2. All the Headmasters of the Government High Schools falling within a Complex, and already assigned with the DDO powers separately, shall continue to exercise the same.

**7. School Visits/Learning Rounds/Field Assessments/Inspections**

7.1. All the designated authorities right from the Director of School Education to the Principals of Complex Schools shall conduct School Visits/Learning Rounds/Field Assessments to assess, review, and monitor the learning levels of the students and to oversee the all-round situation and improvement of the school. These visits shall not become fault-finding missions but shall be aimed at understanding the problems of the school and collaborating to solve them. The purpose of the visits shall be to work jointly to improve learning outcomes and the physical infrastructure. These visits shall be used to identify the gaps and then these gaps shall be addressed. Accordingly, these visits should evolve into a positive, meaningful activity that is participatory in nature. The visitor shall not only identify the problems but shall also devise an action plan with the staff of the school to address the problems in a time-bound manner.

7.2. The Principal of the Complex Head School shall undertake these visits to all schools of the Complex at least once in two months. While conducting the visits, he shall stay for a reasonable time (preferably the whole day, as far as possible) in the school and review the progress and status of important issues, including academic performance. He shall ensure that all the schemes, work, updating of data on portals, and other important academic as well as non-academic aspects of the school are not only reviewed but that teachers are guided and motivated to improve their performance. He should also interact with teachers, students, and parents to assess the overall quality of education in the school. He will note all important feedback and submit a brief report to the Deputy Director. He will also take these reports into consideration to finalize the teachers' performance appraisals.

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- 7.3. The Block Elementary Education Officer shall continue to undertake educational visits/inspections of each primary school and elementary school in accordance with the instructions of the Government issued from time to time. He shall submit a report to the Deputy Director with a copy to the Principal of the Complex Head School.
- 7.4. The Centre Head Teacher shall also continue to undertake educational visits/inspections of all primary schools falling under his jurisdiction as per the instructions issued by the Government from time to time. He will submit the inspection report to the Principal with a copy to the BEEO.
- 8. **Academic Assessment and Grievance Redressal**
  - 8.1. The School Complex shall work in tandem to improve the quality of education by not only resource sharing but skill sharing as well. The teachers of various categories shall hold meetings for discussion and experience sharing on improving the quality of education. In order to resolve the problems of schools in the Complex and to sensitize the parents, joint parent-teacher meetings may be held at the Complex level.
  - 8.2. All teachers of the School Complex shall make all-out efforts to convince the parents to enroll students in government schools in a campaign mode. The teachers of the schools in the Complex whose efforts result in a rise of enrollment of students in a session shall be identified at the Complex level and shall be reported to the Deputy Director.
  - 8.3. The overall performance of each School Complex in terms of these Guidelines shall be graded by a district-level committee notified by the Director of School Education. The School Complexes shall be graded annually as A (Excellent), B (Good), and C (Aspiring). The Complexes graded as C shall be inspected by higher-level officers. Separate Guidelines shall be issued for specifying the criteria for grading the school complexes. The district-level ranking framework shall gradually become an integral part of the ongoing School Rankings under SSA.
  - 8.4. In order to address the grievances of teachers and students, the Principal may constitute a grievance redressal committee at the Complex level consisting of teachers from different schools. Such a committee shall examine all related complaints and grievances and will submit reports/findings to the Principal.

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**Miscellaneous**

- 9.1. These Guidelines shall be applicable with immediate effect and shall be binding upon all concerned. Any instance of non-adherence or non-compliance with these shall be considered misconduct and disobedience of orders of the State Government, and accordingly, the erring teachers/officials shall be liable for disciplinary action as per applicable Conduct Rules.
- 9.2. These shall also govern the teachers engaged under any other policy of the Government for the time being in force. Any violation of these Guidelines shall be dealt with in accordance with the applicable norms of the policy.
- 9.3. The promotional avenues of teachers of any category shall not be affected in any manner because of the enforcement of these Guidelines, and the constitution of the Departmental Promotion Committees shall remain unaltered.
- 9.4. The Director of School Education shall conduct Leadership Training Programmes for all teachers in a phased manner so that everyone understands the spirit of these Guidelines and implements them to improve governance in education and learning outcomes.
