The *Pakhwada* aims to celebrate tribal heritage and promote inclusive development through community engagement and inter-departmental convergence. States/UTs may organise programmes, campaigns, exhibitions and awareness drives under the following broad themes:

- Socio-Economic Development and Awareness
- Education and Skill Development
- Livelihood and Entrepreneurship
- Health and Wellness
- Art, Culture and Heritage
- Infrastructure Development
- Governance and Institutional Strengthening

A suggestive list of activities being undertaken is enclosed as Annexure – I for guidance. States/UTs may adapt and expand these activities in accordance with local priorities and integrate them with ongoing flagship initiatives such as *PM-JANMAN*, *Adi Karmayogi Abhiyaan (AKA)*, *Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyaan (DAJGUA)* and the *Sickle Cell Mission*. Efforts may also be made to ensure convergence among departments and participation of line agencies, TRIs, EMRSs, Ashram Schools, SHGs, PRIs and civil-society organisations.


To ensure effective coordination and visibility, States/UTs are requested to:

The following annexure provides an illustrative set of activities and implementation guidelines for States and Union Territories to celebrate Janjatiya Gaurav Varsh 2025 during the Pakhwada from 1st to 15th November 2025. States may adapt these activities as per local contexts.

A. Curated Activity Menu (States/UTs may pick & adapt)

- Socio-Economic Development & Awareness – IEC campaigns, workshops, tribal melas, cultural programmes.
- Education & Skill – School competitions, digital literacy sessions, teacher training, innovation fairs.
- Livelihood & Entrepreneurship – Exhibitions, start-up clinics, tribal tourism promotion, SHG product sales.
- Health & Wellness – Screening camps, nutrition demos, yoga sessions, mental health counselling.
- Art, Culture & Heritage – Performances, storytelling, exhibitions, film screenings, art workshops.
- Infrastructure Showcases – Inaugurations, model village demonstrations, renewable energy exhibits.
- Governance & Institutions – Gram Sabhas, PRI training, inter-departmental TSP reviews.
- Special Events – Pad Yatras, MY Bharat activities, felicitation of achievers, sports & heritage walks.
- Digital & Media – Social media campaigns, online quizzes, webinars, portal uploads.

B. Suggested 15-Day Calendar (Illustrative)

- Nov 1: State-level launch and press briefing.
- Nov 2: SCD screening camps and nutrition demonstrations.
- Nov 3: School-level competitions in EMRS/Ashram Schools.
- Nov 4: Livelihood fairs and e-commerce onboarding drives.
- Nov 5: Gram Sabhas on convergence and scheme awareness.
- Nov 6: Teacher training and digital literacy bootcamps.
- Nov 7: Cultural performances and documentaries.
- Nov 8: Skill camps and start-up mentoring sessions.
- Nov 9: Mobile health outreach in remote habitations.
- Nov 10: Heritage walks and storytelling on tribal heroes.
- Nov 11: Inauguration of model villages and infrastructure showcases.

- Nov 12: Sports meets in tribal schools (girls' events prioritised). ✓
- Nov 13: Governance review meetings and PRI training.
- Nov 14: Pad Yatras and MY Bharat volunteering drives.
- Nov 15: Felicitation ceremony and summary reporting.

C. Roles & Coordination

- Tribal/Planning Dept- Overall coordination, master schedule, branding, portal uploads.
- Health – Screening, medical camps, data integration.
- Education/Skill – Competitions, teacher & youth training, NSDC partnership.
- Industries/Tourism – Handicraft fairs, market linkages, entrepreneurship sessions.
- Culture/Information – Events, publicity, amplification across media platforms.
- District Administration – Mobilisation, logistics, reporting.

D. KPIs & Minimum Reporting Set

- Coverage – Districts, blocks, GPs covered (TSP vs non-TSP).
- Participation – Number of participants, gender/youth/elderly representation.
- Health – Screenings, AB-PMJAY cards, referral data.
- Education & Skill – Competitions held, students/teachers trained.
- Livelihood – Stalls, artisan sales, e-commerce onboarding.
- Governance – Gram Sabhas held, PRI members trained.
- Culture & Heritage – Events, footfall, local troupe participation.
- Digital Outreach – Online campaigns, reach, webinars, portal entries.
