This Commission is in receipt of references regarding the applicability of the Minority Status Certificate (MSC) granted by it to various institutions.

S.O. (Edu)
2. In exercise of the powers conferred under Article 30(1) of the Constitution of India and the relevant provisions of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004, it is clarified that the MSC shall be applicable only to those schools, colleges, institutions, or courses being run under any trust/society/company which are specifically mentioned in the petition/application filed at the time of grant of such status.

S.O. (Edu)
3. The scope of the MSC shall not automatically extend to any other schools, institutions or courses offered by the concerned Institution unless they are expressly included in the order.

4. In case any Institution has amended its MoA or seeks to extend the ambit of the MSC to additional schools, colleges, institutions, or courses, it shall be required to surrender original MSC issued by the commission and to file a fresh petition before this Commission for appropriate consideration.

5. All concerned authorities and institutions are advised to take note of the above and ensure strict compliance so as to avoid any ambiguity or dispute in the matter.
