



Fourteen (14) such annual events have already been organized with great success. The 15<sup>th</sup> Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad is being organized for three days from February 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2026 at MIT World Peace University, Pune. The basic objective of organizing this conclave is to effectively involve the youth in the democratic process of the country. Chandrababu Naidu, Shri. M. Venkaiah Naidu, Shri. L. K. Advani, Shri Shivraj Patil etc. In addition to these, several eminent personalities like, H.E. Aung San Suu Kyi, Ms. Irina Bokova, Smt. Malala Yousafzai, and Ms. Sunita Williams etc., addressed the conclave through pre-recorded video messages.

3. During the 15<sup>th</sup> Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad, scheduled to be held from February 21 to 23, 2026, deliberations will take place on a number

- Provide a platform to allow young people to participate and organise events on different themes whether cultural, sports, social causes, competitions etc.


