**Subject: Conducting of Scholarship Test viz. "Mere Sheher Ke 100 Ratan" in the State of Himachal Pradesh.**


With reference to the letter issued by the Director of School Education, Himachal Pradesh, Shimla vide letter No. EDN-H(SE)-F(4)-16/2025-QC(Crack Academy), dated 14.05.2026 on the subject cited above, it is informed that a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed between the Government of Himachal Pradesh and the Crack Academy on 12th December, 2024 for a period of three years. As per the terms and conditions of this MoU, a State-wide scholarship test titled "**Mere Sheher Ke 100 Ratan**" is being conducted in all 68 Assembly Constituencies of Himachal Pradesh. The objective of this examination is to provide free scholarships in the form of coaching to the top 100 students from each constituency (total 6,800 students).

In order to ensure smooth conduct of the said examination, the following directions are hereby issued:

1. The examination shall be conducted in all the Government Senior Secondary Schools located in the State of Himachal Pradesh.
2. The date of examination shall be **29th May, 2026** and the examination shall be conducted from **11:00 AM to 12:00 PM**.
3. The students of classes 9th to 12th may be motivated to participate in the examination with great zeal and enthusiasm.
4. The students of Government High Schools falling under the complex of Senior Secondary Schools should also be motivated to participate in the said examination.
5. The tentative number of participating students may be conveyed to this Directorate within three days.
6. The Principals of concerned Government Senior Secondary Schools shall deploy adequate staff for the purpose of invigilation duty.
7. A senior teacher shall be deployed as Centre Superintendent for the said examination.
8. In order to ensure fairness, the concerned Principal shall ensure that CCTV cameras and other preventive measures are properly in place so as to maintain transparency in the results.

The Crack Academy shall ensure timely availability of examination material (Question Papers and Answer Sheets) at the level of all the Deputy Directors (Quality Control)-cum-DPOs.

10. All the Deputy Directors (Quality Control)-cum-DPOs shall ensure that the examination material is supplied to all the Government Senior Secondary Schools falling in their district well before **25th May, 2026** through the concerned BRCCs.
11. After the conclusion of the examination, the answer sheets and other material shall be properly sealed as per the prescribed procedure and should reach back to the concerned DIETs on the same day or positively by the next day for evaluation by the Academy.
12. The Deputy Directors shall ensure that maximum students are motivated and positively reinforced to participate in the examination, as this test will serve as an assessment survey and will help in evaluating the learning levels of students of classes 9th to 12th.
13. The students studying in private schools may also be allowed to participate in the examination and timely intimation may also be given to them.
