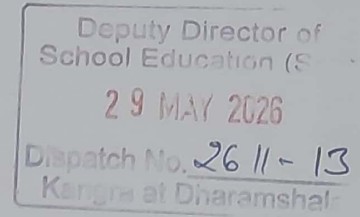

Kindly refer to letter No. Rev(DMC)-PDNA-2023/2026 dated 20-05-2026 received from the Government of Himachal Pradesh, Department of Revenue (DM-Cell) regarding review of implementation status and utilization of funds sanctioned under Rehabilitation & Reconstruction (R&R) Window of NDRF (i.e. PDNA-2023).

In this regard, it has been informed that the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) and the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Government of India, are likely to undertake a review of implementation status and utilization of funds under PDNA-2023 tentatively during the month of June, 2026.

Therefore, all concerned schools are directed to ensure speedy execution and completion of all approved restoration, reconstruction and rehabilitation works under PDNA-2023. The works should incorporate resilient construction practices and disaster risk reduction measures to enhance sustainability and long-term resilience of public infrastructure and assets.

Further, all schools are directed to regularly update physical and financial progress, geo-tagged photographs, utilization details and all other relevant information on the DMIS Portal without delay.

The following information/documents may also be identified, documented and kept readily available for inspection/review:-

1. Good case studies and success stories demonstrating effective implementation.
2. Best practices adopted in project execution and institutional coordination mechanisms.
3. Reconstructed and resilient infrastructure/assets created under the programme.
4. Notable examples reflecting the "Build Back Better (BBB)" approach.
5. Innovative disaster-resilient designs, technologies, mitigation measures and resilient construction practices adopted during restoration/reconstruction works.
6. DPRs, utilization certificates, physical and financial progress reports and related supporting documents.

All relevant records including photographs, progress reports and utilization records must be properly maintained and readily available for the scheduled review and field inspection.

The matter may be treated as top priority and strict compliance ensured.
