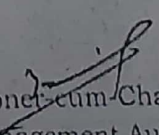

It is further informed that the data available on the HPDMIS serves as the official database for the preparation of the Memorandum of Losses, which is subsequently submitted to the Government of India for conducting the Post Disaster Needs Assessment (PDNA). Any delay or omission in data entry may adversely affect the assessment of disaster impacts as well as the formulation of relief, recovery, and reconstruction proposals.

You are, therefore, requested to accord top priority to this matter and ensure strict compliance with the instructions contained in the enclosed communication.

Himachal Pradesh Disaster Management Information System
(HPDMIS).**

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to inform you that the Department of Revenue (Disaster Management Cell), Government of Himachal Pradesh has developed the Himachal Pradesh Disaster Management Information System (HPDMIS) for reporting disaster-related information, including damage to infrastructure, agriculture, horticulture, water supply, power infrastructure, and other affected sectors.

Further, attention is invited to Para No. 15, Point No. 11 of the minutes of the Monsoon-2026 Preparedness Meeting, wherein the Worthy Chief Secretary to the Government of Himachal Pradesh directed that all losses and damages arising out of disaster incidents shall be compulsorily entered on the HPDMIS Portal by the concerned stakeholder departments.

Accordingly, you are requested to ensure that the losses and damages pertaining to all disaster incidents during the year 2026 are entered on the

HPDMIS Portal (<https://hpdms.hp.gov.in>) in a timely manner through the designated departmental nodal officers. The data entered on the portal should be complete, accurate, duly verified, and updated on a regular basis.

It is pertinent to mention that the data available on the HPDMIS Portal shall serve as the official database for preparation of the Memorandum of Losses to be submitted to the Government of India and for carrying out the Post Disaster Needs Assessment (PDNA). Any delay or omission in data entry may adversely affect the assessment of disaster impacts and the formulation of relief, recovery, and reconstruction proposals.

You are, therefore, requested to issue necessary directions to all concerned field offices and designated officers under your administrative control to ensure timely entry and validation of the requisite data on the HPDMIS Portal. The matter may kindly be accorded top priority.
