Rules and Regulations

Introduction:

The objective of the State Level Science Seminar is to inculcate a spirit of scientific enquiry and analytical thinking among young minds. The Science Seminar is conducted on a competitive basis across States and Union Territories.

Eligibility and Participation

- **Participants:** High school students from Class VIII to Class X only.
- **Language:** English, Hindi or any recognized Indian language.
- **Presentation Duration:** Maximum of 6 minutes, using supplementary visuals or presentations as per rules. Followed by a 2-minute Question-Answer session with the judges.
- **Teacher's Role:** Teachers may assist in managing visuals only. They cannot assist in speech delivery.

Norms for State Level Science Seminar:

1. Only one participant per school may participate, certified by the school.
2. Participants must send write-up of his/her presentation, either typed or legibly hand-written on A4 sheet.
3. The Committee for Science Activities at SCERT will scrutinize the received write-ups. And the shortlisted candidates will be invited through official letter from SCERT to Participate in State level Science Seminar.
4. The shortlisted candidates shall send video of his/her presentation on the given topic for a maximum duration of 6 minutes using supplementary visuals (without using any written Script) where presenter & presentation/visuals should be clearly visible and he/she should

be clearly audible.

5. PowerPoint presentation / images of chart used in visuals and prerecorded video of entire presentation to be sent before the competition. This recorded presentation may be judged in case of disruption of live presentation for any reason (upon State Coordinator and Judges discretion).

6. After each deliberation, each participant will be asked 3 (three) questions by the judges and The participant will be required to answer any 2 questions asked in two minutes.

8. Each participant will be given participation certificate.

Guidelines for Supplementary Visuals:

9. Maximum number: 5 visuals/slides/charts/posters per participant.

10. Allowed formats:

i) Charts/Posters: Maximum size – 850 mm (W) × 600 mm (H). Mounted like calendar pages, one side = one unit.

ii) Computer-based static slides: Office 2007/2010 .ppsx or .pptx format without animations, pop- ups or rollovers.

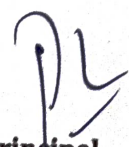
iii) No interaction within a single slide is allowed.

Note:

iv) 3D models, videos, and films are not allowed.

Special Note:

During the presentation, no teacher or escort is allowed to assist the participant, except for physically challenged students.
