THE MINUTES OF MEETING ON INTENSIFIED CAMPAIGN HELD UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SH. BALBIR SINGH, DEPUTY CONTROLLER (F&A), HP STATE AIDS CONTROL SOCIETY ON 23rd JULY 2026 AT HIMACHAL PRADESH STATE AIDS CONTROL SOCIETY, KHALINI, SHIMLA-02 AT 03:00 PM.

The Chairman welcomed all the participants and briefed them about the **Intensified IEC Campaign**, an important initiative launched by the National AIDS Control Organization (NACO) to strengthen HIV/AIDS awareness across the country.

The participants are also briefed that HPSACS has planned to implement **Phase-III of the Intensified IEC Campaign** for a period of two months, with the primary objective of enhancing awareness and education on HIV/AIDS among youth, the general population, key populations, pregnant women, and rural communities. The campaign will be launched across the State on **12th August, 2026**.

The key objectives of the IEC 2026-27 are:

- i. To promote awareness about the 'routes of transmission of HIV.
- ii. To promote literacy on the HIV and AIDS (Prevention & Control) Act 2017 to address stigma and discrimination towards people infected and affected by HIV/AIDS.
- iii. To promote awareness of HIV and Syphilis among pregnant women/ANC attendees
- iv. To create demand for services such as testing for HIV, condom, STI services and promote other services under NACP including the National AIDS Toll-free Helpline 1097.
- v. To strengthen collaboration between various Government departments at State, District, Block and village level administration to promote awareness regarding HIV/AIDS.

In this regard, following decisions were taken for successful organization of campaign:-

Decisions Taken

1. Higher Education Department

The Department shall:

- Issue instructions to all Government and Private Colleges to implement the Digital Awareness Campaign and all RRC activities within the prescribed timelines.
- Issue directions to the identified colleges to organize Flash Mob activities. The list of selected institutions will be provided by HPSACS.

2. Department of School Education

It was decided that the Intensified IEC Campaign will be implemented in all Senior Secondary Schools across eleven districts (except Lahaul & Spiti) through ICTC/STI Counsellors and Targeted Intervention (TI) project staff.

The Department shall:

- Issue instructions to all Deputy Directors of Elementary and Higher Education to facilitate the campaign.
- Support District AIDS Programme Officers (DAPOs) in identifying Private Secondary and Senior Secondary Schools for awareness sessions.
- Ensure that selected schools conduct awareness sessions with the support of DAPOs.
- Coordinate closely with HPSACS for effective implementation.

It was further decided that every participating school shall conduct **3-5 Morning Assembly Awareness Sessions** during the campaign period (12th August to 12th October, 2026) on topics such as:

- HIV/AIDS Prevention
- Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs)
- Adolescent Education
- Tuberculosis (TB)
- Drug Abuse Prevention

The content for these sessions shall be jointly finalized by HPSACS and the Department of Higher Education and circulated to all concerned institutions.

3. Department of Technical Education

The Department shall issue necessary instructions to all Polytechnics, ITIs, Engineering Colleges, and other Technical Institutions to implement the Digital Awareness Campaign and RRC activities within the prescribed timelines.

4. Himachal Pradesh University and Sardar Patel University

Both Universities shall instruct all affiliated colleges and functional Red Ribbon Clubs to organize campaign activities as per the prescribed schedule.

5. IITs, IIITs, NITs, IIMs and NIFT

These premier institutions shall implement the Digital Awareness Campaign and all Red Ribbon Club activities during the campaign period.

The following activities are to be organized for at village and panchayat level institutions:-

Decisions Taken

1. It was decided that the HIV Pledge shall be administered in all Gram Panchayats across all twelve districts on **2nd October, 2026**.
2. HPSACS shall provide printed pledge panels and IEC materials to the Panchayati Raj Department at the Block level for onward distribution to Gram Panchayats.
3. The Department of Panchayati Raj shall issue necessary instructions to District and Block-level officials to facilitate implementation of the campaign and ensure inclusion of the HIV Pledge as an agenda item during Gram Sabha meetings on **2nd October, 2026**.

Agenda Item No. 4: Door to Door Campaign through ASHA Workers and other activities

The following activities are to be organized:-

Decisions Taken

1. ASHA Workers shall be sensitized on HIV/AIDS and the Intensified IEC Campaign through virtual training sessions conducted by District AIDS Programme Officers.
2. A total of **998 ASHA Workers** from Hamirpur, Kangra, Mandi, Solan, and Una districts shall receive an honorarium from HPSACS for conducting a five-day door-to-door awareness campaign.
3. ASHA Workers shall:
 - Conduct household visits.
 - Distribute IEC materials.
 - Educate community members regarding HIV/AIDS, STIs, and Tuberculosis.
 - Encourage completion of the Online HIV Self-Risk Assessment Tool through the SOCH QR Code and the Breakfree India Portal.
4. As per NACO guidelines, the State shall strive to achieve completion of the Online HIV Self-Risk Assessment Tool by **at least 50% of the assigned households (52,500 households out of 1,05,000 households)**.
5. HPSACS shall recognize the top three performing districts based on the highest uptake of the Online HIV Self-Risk Assessment Tool.

The suggested performance categories shall be:

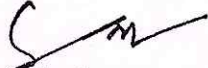
- **Outstanding:** Above 15%
- **Excellent:** 12-14.9%
- **Very Good:** 10-11.9%
- **Good:** 7-9.9%
- **Needs Improvement:** Below 7%

6. **Reporting:** The reporting and visuals of "intensified campaign" will be shared by the concerned during and after completion of the activity on daily basis. The reporting format also attached at **Annexure '2'**.
7. The National Health Mission (NHM) shall extend full support by issuing necessary instructions to all Panchayats, District and Block-level officials to facilitate successful implementation of the campaign.

Agenda Item No. 5: Suggestions by Departments

The representatives from various departments appreciated the initiative taken by HPSACS and assured full cooperation for the successful implementation of the Intensified IEC Campaign. They emphasized the importance of inter-departmental coordination, timely dissemination of IEC materials, and regular monitoring to ensure effective outreach across the State.
