Swachh Evam Harit Vidyalaya Rating (SHVR) 2026-27 empowers schools to assess themselves under six key categories- Water, Toilets, Handwashing with Soap, Operation & Maintenance, Behaviour Change & Capacity Building and Mission LiFE activities and be recognized at District, State, and National levels.



KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- SHVR aligns with National Education Policy 2020 promoting citizenship skills, values and environmental awareness.
- Six key packages – Toilet, Handwashing with Soap, Water, Operation and Maintenance, Behaviour Change and Capacity Building, Mission LiFE Activities.
- Effective functioning using ICT tools, behaviour change communication, innovative financing and partnerships.
- SHVR-based situation analysis helps identify infrastructure and service gaps and supports school level Swachhata Action Plan (SSAP) under Samagra Shiksha.
- Key stakeholders include Rural/Urban Local Bodies, Government Agencies (Districts and States/UTs) and Civil Society Organizations.
- SVP 2021–22: Participation of approx. 8.23 lakh schools from all States & UTs. The initiative was upgraded to SHVR in 2025–26, and the next cycle, SHVR 2026–27, is now being rolled out nationwide.

2. Organize District-level orientation and capacity-building Programmes for Schools after the National/State-level orientation.
3. Ensure 100% registration and participation of all eligible schools within the prescribed timelines.
4. Monitor the progress of registration and Self-assessment on a regular basis and provide necessary handholding support to Schools.
5. Coordinate with all concerned stakeholders to facilitate timely completion of the Self-Assessment Process.
6. Submit Periodic Progress Reports to the State Project Office, Samagra Shiksha, as and when sought.

The SHVR Programme is a significant national initiative for promoting Water, Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH), Sustainability, and Mission LiFE Activities in schools. Therefore, All Deputy Directors (School Education, QC) shall personally monitor the implementation to ensure 100% participation and timely completion of the Programme. The Ministry's D.O. letter, SHVR Guidelines and implementation timeline are enclosed for strict compliance and necessary action.
